

Planting the seeds for tomorrow

The remaining vegetation surrounding our Waterloo wind farm is fairly sparse, having previously been cleared for agricultural use. EnergyAustralia has been working to increase native vegetation at the site, which will improve biodiversity and benefit wildlife. Revegetation will also restore plants and grasses removed during construction of the wind farm and reduce erosion.

We've hired local experts to help revegetate the land. In 2012, a team of revegetation specialists collected 750kg of native grass creating one of the region's largest native seed banks. From this shared resource, we've also planted 120kg of seeds over 10 hectares. This year, we hope to complete the revegetation program with further seeding to take place.
