Aims

- Share information, research, knowledge, skills and experiences
- Communicate well as a group
- Enable effective two-way communication to and from the local community
- Identify and discuss key community issues and opportunities and topics of interest
- Produce beneficial results and positive outcomes for the community, environment, economy (including agriculture and tourism), Waterloo Wind Farm and its employees
- Support community harmony and environmental care.

Group Behaviours

- Respect each other
- Allow all to express views
- Listen well
- Be open to the opinions of others
- Act in an open, honest, professional and courteous manner
- Look for opportunities to reconcile differences
- Agree to disagree when required
- Understand the limitations of the group
- Recognise different knowledge levels within the group and provide up-skill opportunities
- Respect confidentiality and avoid 'naming names' when informing the wider community
- Concentrate on the issues and opportunities, rather than who raises them
- Be genuine and accountable
- Commit to attending meetings whenever possible or provide advance notice of non-attendance.
